B. RE-ENTRY SCENARIOS

3. SCENARIO #3-Students in all grades Pre-K-12 have an A/B schedule and receive part in-person learning and part remote learning
4. SCENARIO #4-All students participate in 100% remote learning

1. Should we go into full virtual education, will the satellite schools still be utilized in some manner or will it be closed. Could they be used as extended classrooms for lower grade students should the district go to A/B schedule.

D. TIMELINE

1. SCENARIO #1-Teachers first day of work August 4, 2020. Students first day of school August 6, 2020.
2. SCENARIO #2-Teachers first day of work August 4, 2020. Students first day of school August 20, 2020. Providing faculty to prepare for safety screening and protocols for students re-entering schools. This would extend the school year by two weeks.
3. SCENARIO #3-Proposed extended school year schedule. Yearlong schedule.
