Basic Speech Skills



- Throughout toddlerhood you child is learning critical language and enunciation skills

The basics of how to read a book



- Children aren't born with an innate knowledge that text is reading from left to right

Better communication skills

- When you spend time reading with your child they will be much more likely to express themselves and relate to others in a healthy way

Mastery of language

- Early reading for toddlers has been linked to a better grasp of fundamentals of language as the approach school age.

More logical thinking skills

- Ability to apply what they have learned to different situations they are experiencing

Acclamation to new experiences

- As your child approaches a major development milestone sharing a relevant story is a great way to help ease the transition.

Enhanced concentration and discipline

- Practice makes perfect
