**Dear Parents and Guardians,**

**Tuba City Unified School District has been working diligently to develop a plan to meet the needs of all students with disabilities beginning on August 17, 2020. It is important that all students with disabilities continue to receive their free and appropriate public education (FAPE) in the same manner as their general education peers. Special education case managers and related service providers will be contacting students and families on their case load to discuss the manner in which special education and related service(s) will be provided to your student through distance learning. Service delivery and time will vary based on the Individual Education Plan.**

**The TCUSD general education teachers will be provided a copy of the student's accommodations. The teachers will provide the appropriate accommodations and modifications to all students with disabilities. Both general and special education teachers will collaborate to ensure all students with disabilities have the same access to the general education curriculum.**

**The IEP meetings and multidisciplinary meetings scheduled from August 17, 2020 through October 2020 will be conducted virtually through zoom or telephone conferences. The special education teachers will e-mail or call families to schedule meetings. Please make yourself and your student available for the meeting as you both are important members of the team.**

**If at any time an initial or re-evaluation is needed the multidisciplinary team will ensure testing will be done in a timely manner to meet the 60-day timeline. Testing may require in-person testing if student is unable to test virtually. This will be on an individual basis. All evaluations must accurately reflect the student's academic, social, adaptive, communication and physical abilities.**

**Tuba City Unified School District understands your concern for the health and safety of your child with special needs and we will do what is mandated in their Individual Education Plan (IEP) to the extent possible. On behalf of the TCUSD Exceptional Student Services we appreciate your patience and understanding as we work through the challenges we are facing.**
