All Native Language Teachers will develop a Curriculum, Curriculum guilde, lesson plans in building content on Language acquistion in Navajo, Hopi and Southern Piaute Language. Also TCUSD will use the Navajo Nation Oral Language and Bilingual seal test to support our Navajo Language Program.

6. Objective(s):

TCUSD Students will increase Navajo Language oral fluency and comprehension by 3% uising Dine Language assessment across the school district. TCUSD will increase their ability to read, write and comprehenion by 3% and all high school may take the Navajo Nation Bilingual seal test at the end of the year. TCUSD students will take the pre and post test for Navajo Language assessment to show growth.
