Dear TCUSD Families and Staff,

We want to inform you about a cybersecurity incident involving PowerSchool, our student information system provider. PowerSchool serves over 16,000 school districts and 50 million students worldwide. Recently, PowerSchool identified unauthorized access to certain customer data, impacting multiple districts, including Tuba City Unified School District (TCUSD). The breach involved a compromised credential that allowed unauthorized access to directory and demographic information, including names, addresses, birthdates, phone numbers, gender, grade levels, student numbers, and parent/guardian contact details. For some students, limited medical information such as doctor names and allergies may have been accessed. Social Security numbers, financial data, and passwords were NOT compromised.

PowerSchool has taken immediate action to contain the breach, secure its systems, and prevent further unauthorized access. They are working with federal authorities and third-party cybersecurity experts to investigate the incident. There is no evidence at this time that the compromised data has been misused. This breach occurred on PowerSchool's end and did not impact any other TCUSD systems.

As part of its response, PowerSchool has begun reaching out to affected individuals to provide a complimentary two-year identity protection plan. This includes identity monitoring for students and staff, and credit monitoring services for adults whose data was impacted. If you receive a notification from PowerSchool, we strongly encourage you to enroll in this protection as a precautionary measure.

At TCUSD, we take cybersecurity and data privacy seriously. We will continue monitoring this situation and working with PowerSchool to ensure the safety of our students and staff.
